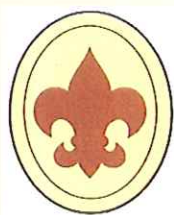

Section 3: The costs of the troop

- ▶ Our income to operate the troop comes in large part from
 - Annual Dues paid by the scouts,
 - Contributions from individuals and companies,
 - BSA popcorn sale proceeds and
 - VG's Receipts give back program



\$ 5,000

- ▶ Our annual operating budget is roughly \$5,000 – the top 4 areas of expense are:
 - Advancement Materials and Courts of Honor
 - General Operating Expenses
 - Troop Camping Gear
 - Trailer insurance

- Other large expenses beyond operating include:
 - Registration expense with the National BSA (funded by the scout's family) and
 - the cost of our annual Summer camp week at Camp Tapico (funded by scout's family).
 - The typical Troop 219 weekend outing is \$20. Fundraising thru popcorn sales can substantially offset this expense when a scout actively sells popcorn.
 - Troop 219 offers camperships to scouts in need of help and supports youth and adult training costs
 - We are a thrifty troop !

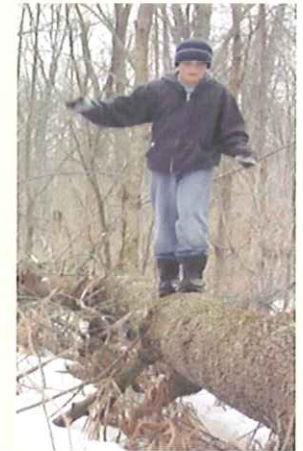

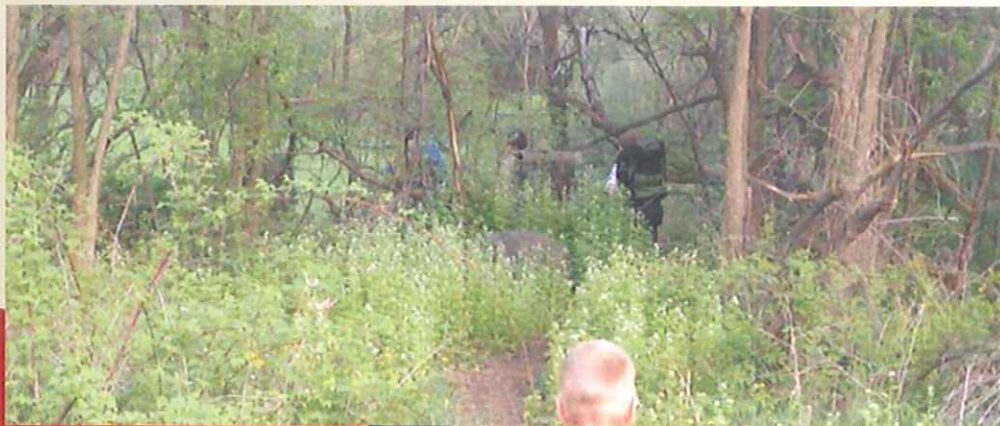
