- 1. The negotiations for the collection of the 2021 summer school tax, as certified by school districts within Tyrone Township, are authorized.
- 2. The Supervisor, Mike Cunningham, and Treasurer, Jennifer Eden, are authorized and directed to negotiate on behalf of Tyrone Township.
- 3. These taxes will be levied commencing July 1, 2021.
- 4. Should an agreement not be determined to cover reasonable expenses, Tyrone Township will not be responsible for the collection of the above tax.

PEG Coordinator Responsibilities

I have listed the responsibilities from what I spend the most time doing.

Consulting

For the most part, the schools, municipalities and board has relied on my opinion for equipment purchases. Majority of the time I spend is reviewing and researching requested equipment and making recommendations.

I think this has been the the biggest advantage of my position and has made a huge difference in the actual use of equipment purchased.

Coordination

In most cases, I am answering emails, and pointing teachers in the right direction on questions they may have, or directing them to the correct person to get the answers they need.

On some occasions, I have also attended school events in person to help set up, troubleshoot, and coordinate filming.

Over the years this has become less and less as teachers and students have become more familiar with how to film these events.

Especially now with COVID, I do not expect to be attending events for the foreseeable future.

Equipment Troubleshooting and Repair

In most instances the schools have been able to take care of software related troubleshooting and repairs. But often I have helped restore computers, fix hardware, take computers to Apple for repair under warranty, and troubleshoot and inform teachers on the more advanced equipment.

This has led to less equipment being set aside and not used.

Content Management

When I first started, this area took up most of my time. But as we transitioned to a YouTube based content management, my time spent in the area has become less and less. The schools have been able to organize and upload their content without any coordination from me.

Letting the schools control their own content has increased viewership and outreach to the community online.

To summarize, I am still, and will handle all the responsibilities outlined in my original contract. I am just doing less of it now, and the amount of coordination needed to keep things organized are becoming less and less. Especially with covid and the my lack of personal availability moving forward, it would be reasonable for the board to decrease funding for my contract.

Moving forward, I believe most of my attention should be directed towards a final upgrade to the broadcast system at Fenton City Hall. I have had nothing but issues

with that system, and have started looking for a replacement that better fits the way we are doing things now.

I have enjoyed working with the schools and municipalities over the years and feel that I have built good relationships with everyone. I hope to continue to build them as long as I am needed.
