## 2022 ELECTIONS

**August 2, 2022 State Primary**  
**November 8, 2022 State General**

### Registering to Vote:

With the passage of Proposal 18-3, an unregistered elector (or a registered elector who has moved) who wishes to vote in an upcoming election has the following options to register:

- ⇒ In person at a Secretary of State branch, a designated voter registration agency, the voter’s county, city, or township clerk’s office or by mail no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> day prior to the election.
- ⇒ Register to vote within the 14 days\* prior to the election, including Election Day, by applying in person at the city or township clerk’s office.

\* Those who register to vote in person within the 14 days must show proof of residency. Documents that may be accepted as proof of residency (documents MUST include the applicant’s name and current address):

- A current utility bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- Government check
- Other government document

### To register to vote in Michigan you must be:

- A resident of Michigan and the city or township you are applying to register to vote for at least 30 days before Election Day.
- A citizen of the United States of America
- At least 18 years of age (by Election Day)
- Not serving a sentence in jail or prison

### Absentee Voting:

Tyrone Township maintains a permanent absent voter list. If you are on the list, the township will automatically mail you an **application** prior to each election. When the application is completed and signed, return it to the township and your ballot will be mailed. If you are a registered voter and want to be added to the permanent list, please contact the clerk’s department. To request an absentee application, contact the clerk’s department or online at the Michigan Voter Information Center.

Tyrone Township has two drop boxes located outside the building and one inside the lobby if you prefer to bring these items into the office.

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### REAL ID

Beginning May 3rd, 2023, your driver’s license or state ID card must be REAL ID compliant if you wish to use it to fly domestically in the U.S. or enter certain federal facilities. More information is available at the Secretary of State’s website;

# 2022 Property Tax Collections:

Summer Taxes are collected from July 1st, 2022 to September 14th, 2022. After 9/14/22 we can collect at the township, but 1% interest is added each month to the balance due through 2/28/2023.

## Payments can be made as follows:

- ◆ One of two drop boxes located at township entrance including a drive up one near building.
- ◆ By mail - postmarks are **NOT** accepted for mailed payments.
- ◆ Local banks include The State Bank & Flagstar Bank, Fenton Branch locations ONLY. during regular business hours-- full payment along with the tax payment stub is required.
- ◆ Online at our website [www.tyronetownship.us](http://www.tyronetownship.us) follow instructions provided under the orange "Property Search and Bill Pay" button. Fees apply for this service.
- ◆ Cashier's department at the township hall.



If you need a receipt please provide a self addressed stamped envelope when using the drop box or mail, online payment option allows you to print a receipt for your records. If you have an escrow account with your mortgage company, it is your responsibility to confirm that they paid your taxes. Deferments need to be turned in by 9/14/22 - contact our office or website for "Application for Deferment" on summer taxes.

## Here's a note to our Snowbirds:

We are finding that if we mail your Tax bills or Sewer O&M bills to your principal address, the bill then gets forwarded to your temporary address. *(The post office doesn't treat forwarded mail as 1st class mail)*. This sometimes adds weeks to get them to you and makes it impossible to get the payment to us by the due date.

### WHY LICENSE YOUR DOG?

- ⇒ Returns Lost Dogs Home Quickly
- ⇒ Rabies Control/Prevention
- ⇒ Required By Michigan State Law

All dogs in Livingston County must be licensed. Licenses may be purchased at Tyrone Township Hall or Livingston County Treasurers office. Dog licenses should be renewed in the same month that the rabies shot was given. One year and three year licenses are available depending on the expiration of rabies vaccination. Proof of rabies vaccination is required for license renewal. The cost for a **spayed/neutered** pet is \$10 for one year and \$25 for a three year license. The cost for an intact pet (**not spayed/neutered**) is \$25 for one year and \$60 for three years.

## ATTENTION

Burn Permits are no longer required!  
You must still follow the **OPEN BURNING ORDINANCE!**  
You will be fined if you burn outside the Open Burning Ordinance.



**MEETINGS**

**Township Board** meetings are held the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 pm. The Board is responsible for the fiscal management of the township and sets township policy.

**Planning Commission** meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 pm. Workshop meetings are at 6:00 pm the third Wednesday of the month. In addition to reviewing applications for land uses within the township, the Planning Commission develops regulations so businesses and residents can peacefully coexist.

**Zoning Board of Appeals** meets on the 2nd Monday of the month at 7:00 pm when requested. The ZBA is created to provide residents a forum at which they can appeal issues arising from interpretations of the township's zoning ordinance.

Transparency on township finances to our residents is available in our Citizens Guide, along with our annual audits. They are available on our website or at the township hall for review in the Clerk's department.
