Donations are greatly appreciated and help feed hungry people and pets. The Pet Pantry also accepts pet-related items.



2023 SUMMER PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION:

Summer taxes are collected from July 1, 2023 to September 14, 2023.

After 9/14/23 we can collect at the township, but 1% interest is added each month to the balance through 2/29/2024

Payments can be made as follows:

- One of two drop boxes located at the township including a drive up drop box & one near the front entrance.
- **By mail - postmarks are *NOT* accepted for mailed payments, allow extra time!!**

We have had a great number of residents who have had issues with the USPS taking longer than expected. If you are mailing your check, please give a sufficient amount of time for us to receive your payment (to avoid any late fees.)

- Local banks include The State Bank & Flagstar Bank, Fenton Branch locations ONLY during regular business hours-- full payment along with the tax payment stub is required.
- Online at our website www.tyronetownship.us Click the green PAY NOW tab and search your property address. ***(Fees apply for this service).***

If you would like a receipt, please provide a **self addressed stamped envelope**

when using the drop box or USPS.

Online payment options allow you to print a receipt for your records.

If you have an escrow account with your mortgage company, **it is your responsibility to confirm that they paid your taxes.**

Deferments need to be turned in by 9/14/23 contact our office or website for "Applications for Deferment" on summer taxes.

PASSPORTS

Tyrone Township is a one-stop passport acceptance facility. Applications and photos are available on site. **Appointments are required.**

We process applications Monday - Thursday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm.

For requirements visit the U.S. Department of State's website at www.travel.state.gov. Please note payments must be made by separate check or money order for each application.

Effective May 7, 2025, your driver's license or state ID card must be REAL ID compliant if you wish to use it to fly domestically in the U.S. or enter certain federal facilities. More information is available at the Secretary of State's website; www.michigan.gov/sos/license-id/real-id

WHY LICENSE YOUR DOG?

- ◆ Returns Lost Dogs Home Quickly
- ◆ Rabies Control/Prevention
- ◆ Required By Michigan State Law

All dogs in Livingston County must be licensed. Licenses may be purchased at Tyrone Township Hall or Livingston County website. www.livgov.com

Dog licenses should be renewed in the same month that the rabies shot was given. One year and three year licenses are available depending on the expiration of rabies vaccination. Proof of rabies vaccination is required for license renewal. The cost for a *spayed/neutered* pet is \$10 for one year and \$25 for a three year license. The cost for an intact pet (not spayed/neutered) is \$25 for one year and \$60 for three years. **Replacement tags are \$5.00**

- Buy a brick, leave a legacy, preserve local history! We have launched a fundraiser for an engraved brick walkway that will be installed in front of our Historic Town House!

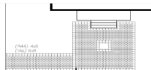
**Bricks are available in two sizes and at two price points for purchase and engraving.

The Township Board has removed the \$5.00 burn permit fee, however you must still follow the:

OPEN BURNING ORDINANCE

Burning outside of the OPEN BURNING ORDINANCE may result in a **FIRE RUN SERVICE CHARGE** of \$1,476.00 (if the fire department is called) and/or a fine. You may get a copy of the ordinance at www.tyronetownship.us or pick up a copy at the township hall.

**WHEN IN DOUBT,
DON'T BURN!**

Tyrone Township DOES accept Cash, Checks & Credit Card payments in person.

We DO NOT take payments for any department over the phone.

Fees apply when using a Credit Card or E-Check on-line

Service fee is 3% of amount charged or a minimum CHARGE of \$2.00.

E-Checks have a \$3.00 charge (E-Checks available online only)



Understanding Your Sewer Bill

We bill quarterly for those of you who are on the sewer system.

January, April, July & October

Payment is due the last Thursday of the month you are billed. We **DO NOT** accept post marks for ANY payments at the township. However, we do have two drop boxes on the property, a drive up drop box, and a drop box by the main entrance.

Penalty is applied to any payments received after 5pm on the due date.

On September 1st, if you have any delinquent sewer payments that have not been made, the balance is automatically transferred to your winter tax bill as a special assessment and includes interest and late fees.

We hope this information is helpful.



We strongly recommend that you make an appointment or call ahead.

General Office Hours: 9:00 AM-5:00 PM Mon. thru Thurs. except Holidays.

Services include: Voter Registration, Absentee Ballots, Tax & Sewer Payments, Dog Licenses, Passports, Burn Permits, Notary Services and General Information.

Planning and Zoning Administration: 9:00 AM-5:00 PM Mon. thru Thurs.

Services include: Land Use Permits, Site Inspections, Planning Department Applications, Zoning Board of Appeals Applications, and all other general ordinance and planning activities.

Assessing Department: 9:00 AM-5:00 PM Mon. thru Thurs.

Services include: Property Transfer Affidavits, Homestead Exemptions, Board of Review, Assessor's Records, and other general assessing information.

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Hours: Monday—Thursday 9 am—5pm

Township Board meetings are held the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 pm. The Board is responsible for the fiscal management of the township and sets township policy.

Planning Commission meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 pm. Workshop meetings are at 6:00 pm the third Wednesday of the month. In addition to reviewing applications for land uses within the township, the Planning Commission develops regulations so businesses and residents can peacefully coexist.

Zoning Board of Appeals meets on the 2nd Monday of the month at 7:00 pm when requested. The ZBA is created to provide residents a forum at which they can appeal issues arising from interpretations of the township's zoning ordinance.
